**ORDER**

M/s. Dafa Builders (OPC) Private Limited (hereinafter referred to as the Company), having share capital, was incorporated on 15.05.2019 but the Appellant Director failed to file the declaration in e-form INC 20A within the prescribed period of 180 days from the date of incorporation, as required under sub-clause (a) of sub-Section (1) of Section 10A of the Companies Act, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the Act, 2013) and had filed the said form belatedly with a delay of 01 day on 12.11.2019. The Registrar of Companies, Kerala and Lakshadweep examined the said default and passed the Adjudication Order No. ROC/S-454/10A/350/2020 dated 03.02.2020 (impugned Order) under Section 454 (3) & (4) of the Act, 2013 for the delay of 01 day in filing the Form INC-20A under Section 10A(2) of the Act, 2013 read with Rule 23A of the Companies (Incorporation) Rules, 2014 (hereinafter referred to as the Rules, 2014) and imposed a penalty of Rs. 50,000/- upon the Company and Rs. 1,000/- upon the Director in default viz. Shri. Gitin Jacob George @ Rs. 1,000/- per day.

2. Aggrieved by the above said Order dated 03.02.2020, the instant appeal was filed by the Appellants in terms of Section 454 (5) of the Act in Form ADJ on 22.10.2020 vide SRN: R68237593. The appeal was not filed within limitation period due to the unprecedented COVID-19 Pandemic and consequent lock down.

3. The appellants have sought condonation of delay keeping in view the size of the Company and no prejudice is caused to the public interest and hence, prayed for setting aside of the impugned order.

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4. An opportunity of being heard was afforded on 30.12.2020 to the Appellants who were represented by their Authorized Representative Shri. S. Narasimman, Senior Manager of M/s. SAS Partners Corporate Advisors Private Limited who had reiterated the submissions made in the application and further stated that the company could not file e-Form INC-20A in time due to technical issues and the delay was only 01 day and hence, prayed for setting aside the order.

5. Considering the grounds urged by the Appellants in the Appeal and the submissions made as well as the fact that the Form INC-20A was filed subsequently, the undersigned deems it appropriate to set aside the impugned order dated 03.02.2020 passed by the ROC, Kerala. The Appellants are directed to file order in Form No. INC-28 within a period of 30 days on MCA-21 Portal.
