

4. An opportunity of being heard was given to the Appellants on 26.10.2020. The Authorized Representative Shri. Cheringal Jithesh, PCS appeared for the Appellants while reiterating the grounds already taken, submitted that the delay is only 27 days and the company has also suffered heavy loss of Rs. 11.64 Lakhs in its first year of operations ended on 31.03.2020. The Authorized Representative was asked to state as to when the company started commercial operations but he was not in a position to state the date of commencement. But the admitted fact is that the company did business and no specific reason other than inadvertent delay was ascribed during the hearing.

5. In the aforesaid circumstances and keeping in view that the delay was only 27 days, there is ground in interfering with the impugned adjudication order of the Registrar of Companies to the extent of reducing the quantum of penalty. Accordingly, the penalties are reduced to Rs. 10,000/- on the Company and Rs. 5,000/- for the Director. The Appellants shall pay the penalty in 30 days failing which the ROC, Kerala shall file prosecution for non-compliance of this order under Sec. 454(8) (ii) of the Companies Act, 2013.
